A	Superior performance
B	Above average performance
C	Average performance
D	Below average performance
F	Failing performance
FA	Fail due to lack of attendance
AU	Audit
CE	Credit by Examination
I	Incomplete: Work unfinished at the end of the semester due to illness or other emergency beyond the control of the student.
IP	Course in Progress: Course start/end dates encompass more than one term.
NP	Not passing
NR	Grade not reported
P	Passing
W	Withdraw: Recorded after student formally withdraws from a class.
WIP	Semester/term in progress

*Note: Beginning fall 1990, the grading system includes A+, B+, C+ and D+ categories.*

### Grade Point Average (GPA)

The grade point average is a function of the grading system used to determine academic status such as academic honors, academic probation, and eligibility for graduation.

Grades that calculate into a GPA and their corresponding quality points are:

A+	4 pts	C+	2.5 pts	F	0 pts
A	4 pts	C	2 pts	FA	0 pts
B+	3.5 pts	D+	1.5 pts		
B	3 pts	D	1 pts		

GPA is calculated by multiplying credit hours earned in courses graded A+ - FA by their quality point values, then dividing the sum of quality points by the sum of applicable hours earned.

For graduation and transfer in good standing, students must have a minimum 2.00 GPA.
